ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER

The Administrative Orders filed on March 17, 2020, in case # 20 OP 00001 1B, and February 10, 2022, in case 22 OP 00001 1B are hereby modified. The Administrative Order filed on May 13, 2021, in case # 21 OP 00001 1B is hereby rescinded.

On February 10, 2022, Governor Stephen Sisolak lifted the mask mandate for the State of Nevada effectively immediately. His decision was based on declining Covid-19 and related variants' infectious rates and hospitalizations.

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED effective April 28, 2022, the First Judicial District Court adopts the recommendation of the Carson City Health and Human Services Director (Health Director) to no longer require the Juvenile Detention Center employees to wear masks or facial coverings or require the public to wear masks or provide proof of vaccination to visit detained juveniles at the center. Per the Health Director's

recommendation, health screens for visitors will still be required. Visitors not passing or refusing the health screen will not be permitted to enter the Juvenile Detention Center located at 1545 E. 5th Street Carson City, NV 89701.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that all other provisions in the Administrative Orders filed on March 17, 2020, in case # 20 OP 00001 1B, and on February 10, 2022, in case 22 OP 00001 1B will remain in full force and effect or until modified or rescinded by a subsequent order.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the First Judicial District Court Clerk's Office disseminate copies of the order to the First Judicial District Courts' Juvenile Court Division and Juvenile Services, Carson City Manager, Carson City District Attorney, Nevada State Public Defender, Division of Child and Family Services and Court Appointed Special Advocates.
